

FINGERLESS MITTENS – CROCHET PATTERN

This is a great stash buster pattern. I used Sirdar Jewelspun aran weight yarn and a 4mm hook to make the stitch tight.

Right-hand mitten:

Row 1: Ch 34. Join the foundation chain into a ring by working a slip stitch (ss).

Rows 2-22: Ch1. Work 1 htr in each stitch around. Finish with a ss in the first htr. 34 sts.

If you want to make the wrist-to-thumb part longer, then work some more rows before making the thumb hole below.

Row 23: Ch1. Work 1 htr in the first 21 sts. Ch5, skip 5sts and work 1 htr in the last 8 sts. Finish with a ss in the first htr. 34 sts.

Row 24: Ch1. Work 1htr in the first 21 sts. Work 1 htr in each of the 5ch sts. Work 1 htr in the last 8 sts. Finish with a ss in the first htr. 34 sts.

Rows 25-28: Ch1. Work 1htr in each st around. Finish with a ss in the first htr. 34 sts.

Row 29: Ch1. *Work 1htr in the first 8 sts. Htr2tog.* Repeat from * to * 2 more times. 4 htr. Finish with a ss in the first htr. 31 sts.

Row 30: Ch1. *Work 1htr in the first 7 sts. Htr2tog.* Repeat from * to * 2 more times. 4 htr. Finish with a ss in the first htr. 28 sts.

Row 31: ch1. 1htr in each stitch around. Finish with a ss in the first htr. Cut the yarn and finish off, weaving in any ends.

Left-hand mitten:

Row 1: Ch 34. Join the foundation chain into a ring by working a slip stitch (ss).

Rows 2-22: Ch1. Work 1 htr in each stitch around. Finish with a ss in the first htr. 34 sts.

If you want to make the wrist-to-thumb part longer, then work some more rows before making the thumb hole below.

Row 23: Ch1. Work 1 htr in the first 8 sts. Ch5, skip 5sts and work 1 htr in the last 21 sts. Finish with a ss in the first htr. 34 sts.

Row 24: Ch1. Work 1htr in the first 8 sts. Work 1 htr in each of the 5ch sts. Work 1 htr in the last 21 sts. Finish with a ss in the first htr. 34 sts.

Rows 25-28: Ch1. Work 1htr in each st around. Finish with a ss in the first htr. 34 sts.

Row 29: Ch1. *Work 1htr in the first 8 sts. Htr2tog.* Repeat from * to * 2 more times. 4 htr. Finish with a ss in the first htr. 31 sts.

Row 30: Ch1. *Work 1htr in the first 7 sts. Htr2tog.* Repeat from * to * 2 more times. 4 htr. Finish with a ss in the first htr. 28 sts.

Row 31: ch1. 1htr in each stitch around. Finish with a ss in the first htr. Cut the yarn and finish off, weaving in any ends.
