## **SLOUCHY BEANIE**

This comfy, slouchy beanie features seed stitch divided by columns of knit stitches to give it a wonderful texture.

Yarn: 100g any aran weight yarn

Needles: 4mm x 40cm circular needle; 5mm x 40cm circular needle. Set of 5mm DPNs

Abbreviations: DPN = double pointed needles; k = knit; p = pearl, ssk = slip, slip, knit

## Rib:

Using 4mm circular needle, cast on 88 stitches. Place a marker at the beginning of the row and join, being careful not to twist your stitches.

Row 1: \*k1, p1\* repeat to end.

Row 2 – 6: repeat row 1

## Hat:

Row 1: \*k2, p1, k1\* Repeat until end of row

Row 2: \*k1, p1\* repeat until end of row

Work 52 more rows like this (if you want your beanie less slouchy, do one or two fewer repeats).

## Crown:

Note: Switch to DPNs when the work gets too small for the circular needles.

Row 1: \*ssk, p1, k3, p1, k1\* repeat to end of row

Row 2: \*k2, p1, k1, p1, k1, p1\* repeat to end of row

Row 3: \*ssk, k3, p1, k1\* repeat to end of row

Row 4: \*k1, p1\* repeat to end of row

Row 5: \*ssk, k2, p1, k1\* repeat to end of row

Row 6: \*k2, p1, k1, p1\* repeat to end of row

Row 7: \*ssk, k1, p1, k1\* repeat to end of row

Row 8: \*ssk, k1, p1\* repeat to end of row

Row 9: \*ssk, k1\* repeat to end of row

Row 10: \*ssk\* repeat to end of row

Row 11: \*ssk\* repeat to last stitch, k1

Cut yarn and thread the tail through the remaining stitches, pull taught, fasten off and weave in ends.
